INTRO: (32) Wait

PART A: (8) 3 Kentucky Drags (L)  
(2) 1 Basic  
(4) 2 1 Stagger Lee (R)  
(4) 1 Stomp Double (R) turn ½ left

PART B: (12) 1 Long Horse (L)  
(4) 1 Triple (R)  
(4) 1 Samantha (L)

BREAK 1: (8) 1 Cruel Rhythm (L)

PART C: (8) 2 Ace Steps (L/R)  
(4) 2 1 Rock Heel Step Basic (L) forward  
(4) 1 Drag Back And Turn (R) turn ½ right

BREAK 2: (16) 2 Kitchen Slips (L) turn ½ left each

PART A1: (8) 3 Kentucky Drags (L)  
(2) 1 Basic (L)  
(4) 1 Stagger Lee (R)  
(4) 1 Stomp Double (R) turn ½ left  
(8) 3 Kentucky Drags (L)  
(2) Rock 2

BREAK 1: (8) 1 Cruel Rhythm (L)

REPEAT C 4x - turn ¾ on each drag back & turn

BREAK 2 & 1: (4) 1 Kitchen Slip (L)  
(8) 1 Cruel Rhythm (L)

BRIDGE: (12) 3 Cotton Eyed Joe (L/R/L) ½ left, ¾ right, ¾ left  
(4) 2 2 Rock Heel Slurs (L/R) forward diagonal

REPEAT C 4x - turn ¾ on each drag back & turn

REPEAT C 2x - turn ½ on each drag back & turn

ENDING: (1) Step (L)

## STEPS IN CRUEL SUMMER

### Stagger Lee (4)

Dbl Heel Pause Toe(xif) Pause Step Rock Step  
R L L L R L  
& a1 & 2 & 3 & 4

### Long Horse (12) (L)

(A regular high horse with a ball slide double basic on the end) Why didn't I just say "high horse, ball slide double basic"? I don't know, Long Horse sounds cooler.

### Cruel Rhythm (8)

Step Dbl Ball Ball(xif) Step Dbl Ball Ball(xif) Step Dbl Ball Ball(xif) Step Rock  
Step

### Ace Step (4)

Dbl Heel Step Step(xif) DS DS  
L R R L R L (Completed with opposite footwork as well.)  
& a1 & 2 &a3 &a4

### Rock Heel [Slur] Step Basic (4)

Hop Heel(oif) Slur(pull) Step DS Rock Step  
L R L L R L R  
& 1 & 2 &a3 & 4

### Kitchen Slip (4)

Dbl Heel Heel Slide DS Dbl(ots) Dbl(xif) DS Rock Step  
L R L R L R R R L R  
&a 1 2 3 &a4 &a5 &a6 &a7 & 8

### Rock Heel Slur (2)

Rock Heel(diagonal ots) Slur(pull) Step (Completed with opposite footwork as well.)  
L R L L  
& 1 & 2
