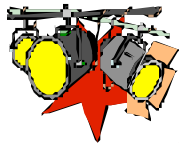

## In Loving Memory

Jacqueline (Jackie) May Eagle, March 28, 1930 - April 3, 2010

Jackie has a special place in the clogging world. We remember her as a gentle, soft spoken person, with a warm smile that communicated her love for dance to her students.

She was introduced to dancing with tap lessons in her youth. It was in 1980 at a square dance that Jackie saw a demonstration by the Stony Mountain Cloggers and became smitten.

The following year she attended a workshop in California and returned home with a manual describing the steps and proceeded to teach herself. She occasionally attended these workshops for further guidance until she found classes in Seattle. Jackie enthusiastically shared these steps with her square dancing friends, forming her own club, the Eagle Cloggers and that's how clog dancing was introduced to the Vancouver district, now including three clubs.

Jackie moved to Kelowna in 2004 and continued to dance with the Brightside Cloggers at the Westside Seniors Center and was soon asked to replace their local instructor who became ill. Next to her family, clogging was Jackie's love and of course "chocolate". We are proud that she was inducted into the American Clogging Hall of Fame and in 2000 honored with the North West Clogging Association Valerie Mackey Award.

Jackie passed away peacefully in North Vancouver with her daughters by her side. Born in The Pas, Manitoba to John Wesley Eagle and Blanche Alice Dupas, Jackie lived most of her life in Vancouver and loved her retirement years in Kelowna, BC. A Memorial Service was held at the Boal Chapel 1505 Lillooet Road, North Vancouver on Saturday, April 10, 2010. She will be lovingly remembered by her daughters Nola and Chris (Peter), brother Bruce (Mary), grandchildren Trevor, Kristen, Kevin, Brandon, Deanna, Lesley, Mark, and Stuart, great-grandchildren Thomas and Carter, nieces, distant relatives and many, many friends.
